OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY Did You Know? Near Misses

A <u>near miss</u> is an incident in which no property was damaged and no personal injury was sustained, but where, given a slight shift in time or position, damage or injury easily could have occurred.

Examples of Near Misses:

- → A forklift operator not seeing a group of pedestrians and coming within inches of striking them.
- → An icicle falling to the sidewalk in front of a pedestrian, but not injuring anyone or damaging any property.
- → An electrician discovering live energy in a light fixture before starting work.

Near Miss Reports help all of us learn from and address safety issues before an injury occurs.
