



## **APPRENTICESHIP Interview & Hiring Update**

The applications for the incoming class of apprentices closed on May 5. Applicants that submitted all of the required information will move on to the phone screening process.

Once all completed applications have had the opportunity for a phone screening, in-person interviews will be scheduled for late June. Incoming apprenticeship first years are expected to onboard in mid-July for orientation and training and will report to their first rotations by August 1.

#### What is Registered **Apprenticeship?**

A federally registered skilled trades apprenticeship is a program that trains and employs individuals who have little or no experience for a career like electrician, plumber, HVAC tech, carpenter, or mason.

Apprentices are paid to work and train with a skilled professional while taking classes to increase their trades knowledge. The U.S. Department of Labor approves these programs at the federal level, so apprentices are guaranteed to learn the right skills and earn a valuable credential if they put in the effort.

Lithium-based batteries have many advantages and are normally very stable. However, if this type of battery fails, the potential fire can spread rapidly and be difficult to extinguish.
